RESPONSE TO COVID-19 HUNGER CRISIS

Covid 19 Food Parcel Program

Food Parcel distribution is part of the emergency response for those who are in critical need of food and have no other means of accessing it, either through deliveries, or help from family and friends.

The program has been hugely successful in getting immediate food and essential supplies to those most in need, with over 70 boxes having been delivered to those in need in the last weeks since the service started in amidst the lock-down.

The delivery of food parcels to those in need was initiated as one of the key strands of the Smile Charity Uganda's response to the current crisis situation. The program has been a major success with a large number of boxes being delivered to those in need.

When the scheme started, we approximated 200 food parcels would be needed, but there is a need

to deliver even more parcels. We believe these packages will motivate our beneficiaries and other people to stay home as a crucial measure to fight the spread of COVID-19 and stay safe.

Food parcel delivery is being done majorly with the help of motor bikes (boda bodas) since majority of transport means have been banned by the government so as to reduce the spread of COVID-19 virus. Our local volunteers opted the use of boda bodas as the effective way to reach out many beneficiaries prone to hunger in this season.

Over ninety people have received their parcels in a period of one week and yet more deliveries are still being made.
